I am writing to object to the current plan for metro style trains in the North West Rail link. In particular the direct line should continue from Beecroft and Cheltenham to the city via Chatswood without the need for changing trains multiple times.

I agree that the Rail link is a much needed project for North Western Sydney however I object to the use of metro trains that would require passengers from existing stations such as Beecroft and Cheltenham to change trains multiple times.
