I wish to make a submission - **OBJECTION SUBMISSION** - to the above Application on the following grounds:

1. The proposal of the **quarry to operate 24 hours per day seven days per week** is far too excessive given that it also means the truck movements would continue during those hours.
2. The **increase in number of truck movements** per hour is also excessive in the extreme and **impacts detrimentally** on: (i) the road surface of Brandy Hill drive along its entire length, a roadway already under stress from the present heavy truck traffic

(ii) health problems from diesel fumes, and the noise from the trucks laboring up the road, and deceleration and compression braking
3. There is no lighting, no footpaths which makes it very dangerous for children waiting on inadequate road side bus stops with hundreds of B-Double trucks 30-40 ton laden screaming past at speeds up to 80k is a nightmare for any parent. In my view the proposal is over the top and ridiculous for this area.
