I wish to make a submission - OBJECTION SUBMISSION - to the above Application on the following grounds:

- 1. The proposal of the **quarry to operate 24 hours per day seven days per week is far too excessive** given that it also means the truck movements would continue during those hours.
- The increase in number of truck movements per hour is also excessive in the extreme and impacts detrimentally on: (i) the road surface of Brandy Hill drive along it's entire length, a roadway already under stress from the present heavy truck traffic

(ii) health problems from diesel fumes, and the noise from the trucks laboring up the road , and deceloration and compression braking

3. There is no lighting, no footpaths which makes it very dangerous for children waiting on inadequate road side bus stops with hundreds of B-Double trucks 30-40 ton laden screaming past at speeds up to 80ks is a nightmare for any parent. In my view the proposal is over the top and ridiculous for this area.
