This is a submission to the Berrima Rail Project EIS SSD7171

I strongly object to this project and recommend that it be rejected.

From the EIS and the DA lodged by Hume Coal it suggests that there will be 4 daily coal trains from the Hume Coal Mine with 4 daily returns. If we are to believe this prediction it will likely be more.

Since moving here 4 years ago the increase of traffic in the region has been very noticeable occasioned by the huge increase in housing development which just seems to be non stop.

Some of my concerns are as follows:

- The train movements we have now are mostly acceptable in their frequency but any more and there will be problems of traffic movement around the shire which will become a burden for those who live here and those passing through.
- I believe there will be close to 30% increase in the total time rail crossings are closed each day 24/7 which would be unacceptable as it would impact emergency vehicles such as police, fire fighting, ambulances and other critical services
- What guarantee is there that the coal wagons will be covered so as not to evenly distribute coal dust over the shire and that the covers will do the job?
