This is a submission to the Berrima Rail Project EIS. SSD7171

I object to this project and recommend that it be rejected.

I object to the above project on the grounds that there will be four daily coal trains from the Berrima mine and back to Port Kembla. This involves 17 level crossings and an added 24 minutes of closures at those crossings every day. This will amount to a total of rising from 69 minutes to 93 minutes every day.

This extra time could be catastrophic on some crossings due to the extra hold up time to emergency vehicles, AS THERE IS NO OTHER LOCAL ACCESS TO SOME COMMUNITIES, EXCEPT ACROSS THESE RAIL CROSSINGS.

There is also the environmental impact to consider, noise, dust, pollution. Some proposes to have the carriages covered. Will this be policed & how, will it be ongoing? How will they stop the wind from blowing across the stacks, causing pollution to the surrounding areas + towns
