This is a submission to the Berrima Rail Project EIS. SSD7171

I object to this project and recommend that it be rejected. on the following grounds

1. The railway line currently available to Hume Coal is inadequate for the proposed use without extensive upgrading.
2. The number of level crossings would produce extreme disruption to traffic over any day - particularly at crossings over highways like the Illawarra at Robertson.
3. Issues for emergency vehicles due to the time taken for trains to pass at level crossing will produce extreme safety issues.
4. Noise issues from trains particularly through Moss Vale and Robertson will inevitably affect amenity - particularly when a 24hr operation is proposed.
