A submission to the Narrabri Gas Project EIS , I reject this proposal.

My name is Jenny Donaldson and I am a farmer living in close proximity to the South East of the proposed Narrabri Project Area, to the west of Boggabri.

I reject this proposal on the grounds that CSG development will cause a loss of community, as is the case so often in the gas fields of Qld. I fear that we will be overrun by "the dead shit factor" experienced by those forced to co-exist with an industry whose employees (predominately FIFO and DIDO) have no connection with our district, and simply don't care. I know of a Qld landholder who has 130 gas wells on his property, who earns\$ 1, 300, 000 (\$10 000 / well) per annum, and does not think it is worth the misery of hundreds of CSG staff on his farm at any one time.

I reject this proposal that CSG development will cause a loss of amenity, a loss of quiet enjoyment, increased dust ,traffic , air pollution, light , noise etc in my local area .

I reject this proposal on the grounds that CSG development on my land , or anywhere near my land will inevitably result in the devaluation of my land , as has been the case in Qld thus far.

I reject this proposal, since the loss of ground water due to CSG activities in Qld is an issue that has never really been addressed properly. In their "make good policy " gas company strategy involves the capping of the 'offending bore', and the offer to purchase the affected landholder. This is not a long term solution.

I reject this company Santos for their role in their manipulation of domestic gas prices , that will lead to far more job losses and hardship , than the employment NGP can ever hope to create.

I emphatically reject this project.
