Concrete Batching Plant, Glebe Island

I write to object to the proposed aggregate handling and concrete facility with shipping terminal at Glebe Island. The current proposal will have a significant impact on the local Jacksons Landing Community as will be within 200 metres of the closest high-rise apartment building.

Currently when boats are in port dumping sand we are severely impacted by generator noise, flood lights and pollution. Allowing this to occur on a continuous 24hour basis demonstrates a total disregard by the NSW Government for the health and well-being of the local community and is simply unacceptable.

The local community in the Jacksons Landing Precinct has grown substantially over the last 10 years on the basis of the NSW Government commitment to this being a residential area. Residents have invested in the area in good faith and their investment and health are now to be impacted by the duplicity of the NSW Government.

It appears there is no master plan for the area and White Bay/Glebe Island is now the target for multiple ad-hoc projects with what appears to be a total disregard of the cumulative impact on the residents. We now have the proposed Multi User Facility, the Concrete Batching Plant and the Western Harbour Tunnel Support Area. Individually each of these projects will have a detrimental impact on local residents and the community and when considered collectively the impact of increased noise, increased pollution and the forecast large number of heavy duty truck movements on local traffic is horrendous.

We ask that the proposal be rejected.
