- 4 Reasons for my objection:
  - a. NATURAL BEAUTY OF THE SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS As a frequent visitor to the Southern Highlands, I admire the pristine, rural beauty of this part of NSW. The introduction of a coal mine to the area would impact on this beauty in much the same way as mines have impacted on areas such as the Wollongong hinterland and the Hunter Valley.
  - b. **NEED TO RESIST ANY POSSIBLE THREAT TO THE WATER SUPPLY OF THE SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS** I am not convinced that the water table of the area would not be affected by the proposed project. Water is a major resource in every area of Australia and any possible threat to this resource in the, as yet, still unaffected Southern Highlands should sensibly be resisted.
