We employ four people earning in excess of \$80k per annum each

We turn off \$9 million worth of livestock per annum purchased primarily in the local area.

Farming within the mine area

We will continue to run a highly productive grazing farm within bounds of an operating mine. As directors of our company we have carefully carried out due diligence on the impacts of water, dust ,noise, traffic and fully believe that the EIS satisfies our concerns and has more than adequately mitigated the risks.

We will bear the brunt if there any adverse impacts from the mine and we are comfortable that any issues would be addressed and mitigated in a timely and effective manner as outlined in the EIS.

300 direct jobs are greatly required in the local area. Our discussions with other local businesses paint an extremely positive picture of the impacts and a great deal of support positions will be required.

The opportunity of taking the licence over the Hume Coal properties has not only moved our family back to the area. In turn our business has been supporting local business by using local businesses for our repairs, cattle purchasing, transport etc.
