This is a submission to the Hume Coal Project EIS. SSD7172

I object to this project and recommend that it be rejected.

- Clean water for all people is paramount. Any threat to clean water should be treated with utmost concern. The proposed Hume Coal Mine poses a serious risk to the Northern Highlands water as well as Sydney.
 - The noise from a mine working 24/7 will impact the impact of this on residents of New Beruna, Beruna, Medway and Moss Vale.
 - Of concern also are potential coal dust and diesel emissions. Moss Vale is frequently windy so the impact on residents, including children, is high.
 - The Hume Coal EIS provides no assurance that the company will not seek to expand the mine in future.
 - Three large stockpiles of virgin thermal coal and tailings (for two years) would be exposed in an otherwise beautifully scenic area.
 - Coal mining rejects, including toxic materials, will be stored where flood, posing a health risk to residents.
