The proposed quarry will impact my workplace Eagleton Ridge respite centre (E.R.R.C) due to noise created from the quarry such as trucks coming and going and crushers working till late hours at night when clients are trying to sleep, due to the quarry being so close to their home.

The vibration caused from the blasting and crushing will most likely scare our clients who have special needs. And the Dust that arises from the movement of all the trucks and the crushing from the heavy vehicles will affect clients that have lung diseases such as asthma, COPD and Bronchitis. Which in turn could make their conditions much worse? This can then also affect our clients' overall health putting a heavier strain on their already struggling health.

If this quarry was to go ahead our clients would be scared from the noise, be at risk of deteriorating health conditions, have affected sleep patterns. As well as some clients who also come in for respite not wanting to come back. Overall affecting the business and our job positions as well. There are too many risks involved to develop such a quarry this close to people who have disabilities.

The farm will be home for 6 people, 4 of whom already reside at the residence and is a place that our clients go to visit the farm animals and do activities during the day from our respite centre in Raymond Terrace 'Bronzewing'. Some clients also do garden work and help around the centre as part of their support, they will be sensitive to noise and will come to dislike the activities that they much enjoy doing on a weekly basis.

The owners whom I have worked with for 16 months have owned their business for the last 17 years and a lot of hard work has gone into making it a success. Our jobs depend on it as do our families and clients and their families. Please don't ruin such a beautiful peaceful serene place for us all to work and live in. It would be simply a tragedy.
