I am against this proposal for a quarry for the following reasons. I have been working as a support worker at Eagleton Ridge Respite Centre for the last 2 years, i enjoy being able to work with my clients at the farm in Eagleton. It is a very peaceful area and the clients love it. I live in the suburbs and would hope that one day I could buy some land in a rural area.

I do not believe that a Respite Centre in a rural area could co exist with a quarry, especially being located so close. The quarry would be a dusty noisy place and especially when there is blasting everything would change for the clients and the staff. When I do sleepover shifts at the farm its quiet, much quieter than when I am at home. The noisiest thing here are the Kookaburras in the morning and the Cockatoos during the day.

The quarry will be a source of noise and it will be constant for periods of time, i can see issues with the noise becoming irritable for some of the clients especially our autistic clients. I would not want to work sleepovers with the sounds of quarrying in the evening and night. I think it is unfair to subject my workplace and the clients home and activity centre to noise and blasting from a quarry. The Respite Centre has been here for a long time, why should something else be allowed to just move in and become a negative issue for what is already established?

I am saddened to think that things might change for the worse here and I hope that my employment here is unaffected in the long term. I mostly hope that our clients will still be able to live and come here without a quarry affecting their existing lifestyle.
