I write this letter of support as the Institute of Quarrying Australia's (IQA) General Manager. Daracon Group is a valued member of the IQA engaging in professional development programs and professional networking opportunities.

The Australian Quarrying Industry has been under increasing pressure to introduce fundamental changes in business practices given the challenges facing the industry. The IQA views Daracon Group as having the foresight and capability to ensure their operations are conducted at the highest levels of professionalism, integrity and corporate social responsibility.

I cite the following positive attributes of the Martins Creek Quarry project:

- The Martins Creek Quarry will support many infrastructure projects (road construction, housing, railway construction etc.) adding lifestyle value to the local communities.
