We strongly oppose the Martin Creek Quarry Expansion for the following reasons.

1. Noise pollution which begins about 4 am on Tolal Road when the trucks are travelling towards Martin Creek.
2. During the rest of the day we have the trucks travelling in both directions causing more noise pollution.
3. One of our main concerns is the exiting and returning into our driveway because of the speed of the trucks and our limited disability. If the expansion is approved to 80 trucks per hour it will be near impossible for us to exit and enter our driveway.
4. We feel that it is only a matter of time before there is a serious accident with that many truck movements.
5. Who pays for the damage to the roads that these trucks cause?

We think that the Dept. of Planning should be looking at closing not expanding the quarry because of the air, pollution, noise pollution, water pollution and other concerns of the people of Martin Creek, Paterson and other surround.
