the application by Paracon to seek
approval for:

an increase in operating hours
430 truck movement a day
80 truck movements per hour
clearing 100ac native vegetation
1.5 million tonne expansion

I strongly oppose this application based
on the number of truck movement per hour.

My husband & I have lived at the
above address for the past 38 years. It is a
25 acre property on the Dungey Rd almost opposite
the turn off to Martins Creek. The noise impact
of the existing trucks is unbearable now, without
extra trips. The safety of vehicles travelling
on this road will be impacted. Not to mention
noise & pollution.

I have just retired and would like to
