this gravel and gabbions size rock 200mm size at the front of our house the smaller gravel falling from these trucks washes down into drains in heavy rain thus blocking it, water then flows at a rapid rates through our property.

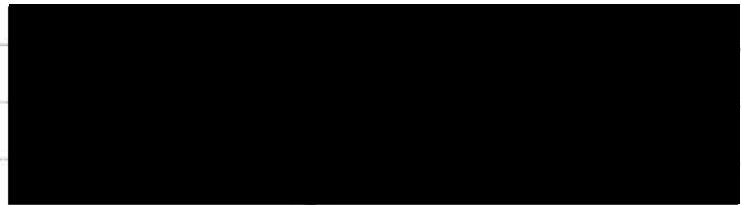
(I have many photos of the trucks, rocks and dust if required.)
