I am writing in order to protest in the strongest possible terms against your proposal to expand activities at the above quarry through the agency of Daracon.

The communities of Martins Creek, Paterson, Bolwarra and Morpeth are all very close together. The proposed expansion will result in a substantial increase in the volume of traffic in the form of the heavy trucks and other forms of transport used by Daracon. They will use the roads which link these communities with great frequency. This will cause great inconvenience to other road users. There will also be great incidence in noise and exhaust fumes, together with other deleterious environmental effects.

I call on you to reconsider your position and not allow this proposal to proceed.
