Thankyou for providing Endeavour Energy with the opportunity to comment on this proposal.

We note that as part of the EIS prepared for the Saints Peter and Paul Assyrian Primary School at Cecil Park, an electrical Infrastructure assessment has been included as Appendix 31. This document describes the present electrical infrastructure available in the area and assesses its capacity to service the school development.

We note that an installation of a padmounted substation is required, and that a site for this substation has been included on the plans for the school- the final location of which, has yet to be determined.

The Assessment summarises Endeavour Energy's process to be followed when applying for the connection of a development to the electricity network.

In doing this, the developer has acknowledged and incorporated the electricity supply requirements into their planning process for their development.

As stated in this Assessment all applications for electricity supply and connection to the electricity supply network must be made via Endeavour Energy's Network Connections Branch, and that Endeavour Energy's processes must be followed.
