**Request for comment – Saints Peter and Paul Assyrian Primary School – 17-19
Kosovich Place, Cecil Park – SSD 9210 – Fairfield LGA**

I refer to the letter dated 5 November 2018 inviting the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) to provide comment on the development application and environmental impact statement for the proposed Saints Peter and Paul Assyrian Primary School (SSD 9210), located at 17-19 Kosovich Place, Cecil Park, in the Fairfield Local Government Area.

On the basis of the information provided, the proposal does not constitute a Scheduled Activity under Schedule 1 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (the POEO Act). The EPA does not consider that the proposal will require an Environment Protection Licence under the POEO Act. The EPA understands that the proposal is not being undertaken by or behalf of a NSW public authority. The EPA is therefore not an appropriate regulatory authority for the proposal.

Accordingly, the EPA has no further comment regarding the proposal and has no further interest in this matter.
