Please find below my submission in response  
 to the exhibition of the EIS for NorthConnex.  
 Firstly we would like to state we object to the  
project as described in the EIS.

I have a high level of concern regarding the  
 following issues and request that these concerns  
 by NorthConnex and the Dept of Planning be considered  
 regards to the North Connex tunnel, I am concerned  
 about:

1. Placement of the northern ventilation stack in  
 the centre of a densely populated residential  
 area in Wahroonga where over 9,300 children  
 will be exposed, as well as multiple aged care  
 facilities, hospitals, business and homes. The  
 southern ventilation system also impacts on  
 the residential areas around it.

2. I am highly concerned about multiple  
 scale research studies that suggest the  
 impacts of air pollutants on health are  
 serious particularly for the young, the elderly,  
 those in poor health and pregnant women.  
 These studies confirm air pollutants have  
 caused serious health problems

To address these concerns I request that the following actions be taken.

1. Due to the significant health concerns of the current project design, I request the department of planning does not approve the project in its current form.
2. I also request that alternative transport options to ease congestion on Pennant Hills Road be considered such as an orbital surface route.
3. If the tunnel goes ahead the top priority should be efficient filtering of the tunnel to minimise health and safety risks to the community inside and outside of the tunnel.
4. Attention should be given to the height of the stacks, to the weather conditions in the area and to the topography of the area. Please keep in mind computer modelling is only as good as the information programmed into the computers.
