## **Submission to North Connex Project**

## Specifically Trelawney Street support facility

I reference a recent leaflet Factsheet received relating to the many adverse effects impacting on local residents during this project

- 1. **Noise** I remain unconvinced that the measures in place will be enough to effectively maintain "quite enjoyment" in my residence. Whilst (as described) in the leaflet in reasonable detail that all practical measures will be put in place along with acoustic hoardings, etc. I ask that some real evidence is supplied to support that these measures are sufficient to ensure we maintain an acceptable level of noise impact. I note that no evidence of any described measures is included in the submission. In reality it is just a "nice" list
- 2. Air Quality Once again I ask that some evidence is supplied as the information is in essence a "nice list". Please expand on the non-specific terms used such as "wherever possible" and "where feasible and reasonable". These non-specific terms are basically useless as they describe nothing. Please also expand on the term "rumble grid" and what effect water carts, sprinklers, etc have. Again I point out, are these working 24/7 what are the specific details? I should also make it clear that I suffer from severe dust allergies and therefore my level of concern and request for more specific information in this area is of significantly more interest than an average resident
- 3. Traffic What real measures are being put in place to ensure that 2 main concerns are addressed? These 2 concerns are (in no particular order) Firstly parking What measures are being put in place to ensure contractors do not use the residential streets (such as Loch Maree Avenue) for parking? Secondly What measures are being put in place to ensure Truck movements do not commence outside of the described Traffic Control Plan?
