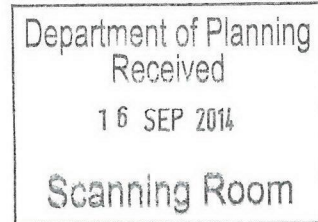


Re: EIS Submission – NorthConnex Proposal
