**STATE SIGNIFICANT DEVELOPMENT SSD7089 – EUROBODALLA ROAD, BODALLA –
EUROBODALLA SOUTHERN STORAGE**

Dear Kate,

Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) refers to your correspondence dated 3 September 2018 regarding the subject state significant development.

RMS has completed an assessment of the development, based on the information provided and focussing on the impact to the State Road Network. For this development, the key state road is the Princes Highway.

RMS notes the majority of traffic volume increases (particularly heavy vehicles) for the development are associated with the haulage of fill materials, during the construction stage, from Eurobodalla Quarry. RMS notes that Eurobodalla Quarry is located close to the proposal site, and the access route is along Nerrigundah Mountain Road and Eurobodalla Road, which are both local roads.

Given the above, RMS does not believe the development will have a significant impact on the State Road Network. On this basis, RMS does not object to the development application.
