**SSI 7734 – MOD 2 EXTENSION OF USE OF THE EDEN CRUISE WHARF TO OTHER VESSELS, EDEN BREAKWATER WHARF, WEECOON STREET, EDEN**

Dear Katherine

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) refers to your correspondence dated 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020 regarding the subject development application.

TfNSW has completed an assessment of the development, based on the information provided and focussing on the impact to the state road network. For this development, the key state road is Princes Highway.

TfNSW notes the modification proposes to extend the use of the Eden Breakwater Wharf to smaller vessels with sizes up to 100m in length. The existing approval allows 60 cruise ships to use the Wharf per annum, however due to Covid19 the cruise industry has stopped.

TfNSW does not believe the development will have a significant impact on the Princes Highway and on this basis, does not object to the development application. Please note Maritime will provide a separate response.
