Notice of Exhibition SSD 8922 - Major Alterations and Additions to the Stevenson Library Building, Scots College 29-53 Victoria Road, Bellevue Hill

Dear Mr Hay,

I refer to your letter received 5 September 2018, requesting input from the Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH) on the Notice of Exhibition for the major alterations and additions to the Stevenson Library Building at Scots College.

Please be advised that in accordance with the recommendations outlined in Clause 14.3 – Historical Archaeological Assessment in the Environmental Impact Statement prepared by BBC Consulting Planners dated July 2018, OEH recommends that the following archaeological management be included in any development consent that may be issued for the site:

- Prior to onsite ground disturbance commencing, the designated project team including all contractors on site should undergo heritage induction, which will include an archaeological awareness component to reinforce the importance of heritage issues and the management measures that will be implemented.
- In the event of an unexpected discovery of archaeological relics during ground disturbance works the Unexpected Find Procedure should be followed. The procedure details the actions to be taken when a previously unidentified and/or potential Aboriginal and/or historical heritage item/object/site is found during construction activities.
