RE: Paling Yards Wind Farm (MP 10_0053)

Thank you for providing the Department of Defence (Defence) with the opportunity to comment on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Paling Yards Wind Farm located in the Oberon local government area. Defence understands that this EIS is to develop 55 wind turbines with a maximum blade tip height of 175m; a total installed capacity of approximately 178MW; associated infrastructure; and an above ground connection to the 500kV Mt Piper to Bannaby transmission line.

Wind farms can have the potential to impact Defence activities, particularly in regard to aircraft safety and radar interference. With this in mind, Defence requests that the applicant provides 'as constructed' details to RAAF Aeronautical Information Service (AIS) for aeronautical charting. with RAAF AIS has а website a Vertical Obstruction Report Form at www.raafais.gov.au/obstr form.htm which can be used to enter the location and height details of tall structures.

Defence requests that the Wind Farm should be lit in accordance with Civil Aviation Safety Regulation 139 and the Civil Aviation Safety Authority Manual of Standards 139. If Light-Emitting Diode (LED) obstruction lighting is applied to the Wind Farm, the frequency range of the emitted LED light is requested to fall within the wavelength range of 655 to 930 nanometres. This will enable the lighting to be visible to persons using night vision devices.

To mitigate potential impacts to Defence activities, Defence requests to be consulted should there be any subsequent modification to the design, scale, location or intensity of the wind farm.
