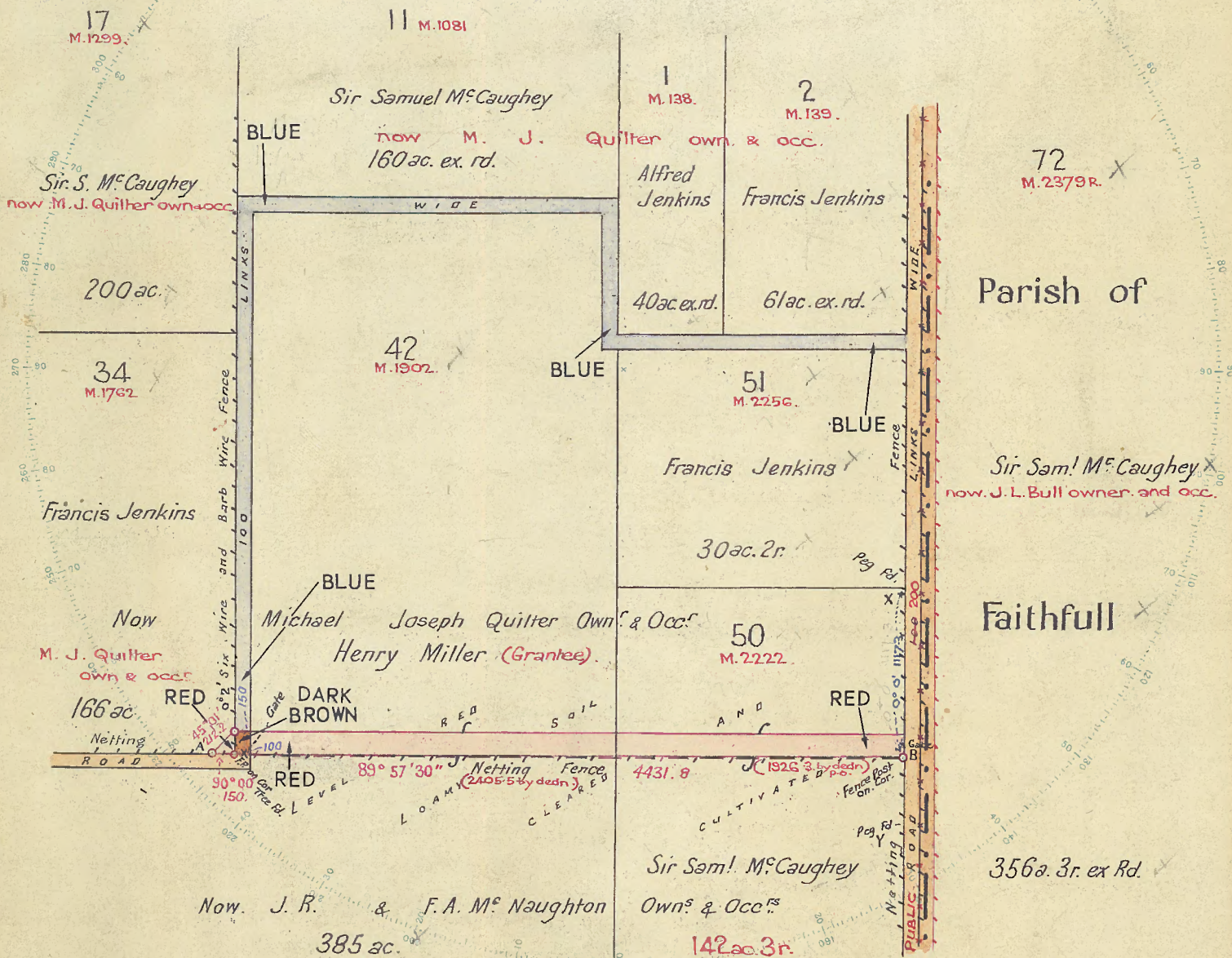

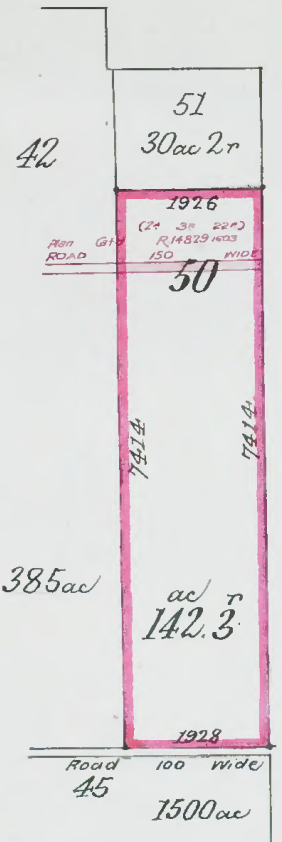

GRANT OF LAND ALLOTTED IN EXCHANGE FOR SURRENDERED LAND.
(UNDER SECTION 47 OF THE CROWN LANDS ACT OF 1895.)



EDWARD VII, by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, King, Defender of the Faith, and so forth:—
TO ALL to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:—

WHEREAS *The British and Australasian Trust and Loan Company Limited* hereinafter called "the said company" was the holder of *Two thousand six hundred and ten* acres of land in Our said State, being Conditional Purchases Nos 1876-225, 1877-23, 1880-34, 1881-34, 1881-45 and 1883-43 in the Land District of Narrandera and 1881-105 in the Land District of Uxana in respect of which a balance of purchase money remained unpaid, and the said company had an absolute right to a grant of the said land in fee simple upon payment of such balances:—
And Whereas on the *Twenty seventh* day of *September* one thousand ~~one~~ hundred and *ninety seven* the Governor of Our said State, acting under the provisions of Section 47 of the Crown Lands Act of 1895, accepted from the said company a surrender of the said land and allotted to him in exchange therefor the Crown lands hereinafter described and hereby intended to be granted together with other Crown lands: And Whereas by divers mesne transfers, and lastly by an instrument of transfer dated the *Twenty fifth* day of *April* one thousand ~~one~~ hundred and *ninety eight* the said lands hereinafter described were duly transferred to *The Honorable Sir Samuel M. Baughay, Knight* in Our said State *Grazier* being desirous of obtaining a grant in fee simple of the land last mentioned, has paid into the Office of the Treasurer of Our said State the balance of purchase money due thereon: AND has done all things required by law to be done to entitle him to the issue of a grant in fee simple of the said lands, subject to the Reservations, Exceptions, Conditions, and Provisions hereinafter contained: *Now Know Ye*, That for and in consideration of the said moneys, for and on Our behalf well and truly paid into the Treasury of Our said State, before these Presents are issued, and of all and singular the premises, We have granted, and for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, Do HEREBY GRANT unto the said *Samuel M. Baughay* His Heirs and Assigns, subject to the several and respective Reservations, Exceptions, Conditions, and Provisions hereinafter mentioned, ALL THAT piece or parcel of land in Our said State, containing by admeasurement *One hundred and forty two acres three roods* and Parish of *Burigo* be the same more or less, situated in the County of *Mitchell*



commencing on the Northern side of a road one chain wide at the South Eastern corner of portion forty two of three hundred and eighty five acres and bounded thence on the South by that road dividing it from portion forty five of one thousand five hundred acres bearing South eighty nine degrees fifty nine minutes East nineteen chains twenty eight links on the East by a line bearing North seventy four chains fourteen links on the North by the Southern boundary of portion fifty one of thirty acres two roods bearing West nineteen chains twenty six links and on the West by a line dividing it from portion forty two aforesaid bearing South seventy four chains fourteen links to the point of commencement.

As per plan in the margin hereof: with all the Rights and Appurtenances whatsoever thereto belonging: To HOLD unto the said *Samuel M. Baughay* His Heirs and Assigns for ever: Subject nevertheless, to the Reservations, Exceptions, Conditions, and Provisions hereinafter contained, that is to say: **Provided** Nevertheless, AND WE DO HEREBY RESERVE unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all Minerals which the said land contains, with full power and authority for Us, Our Heirs and Successors, and such person or persons as shall from time to time be authorized by Us, Our Heirs and Successors, or by the Minister for Mines, or other Minister charged with the administration of the Acts in force for the time being for the regulation of Mining within Our said State, to enter upon the said land, and to search for, mine, dig, and remove the said Minerals, with full right of ingress, egress, and regress, for the purposes aforesaid: **Provided** Also, And it is hereby declared that these presents are made upon and subject to the condition that, if at any time the said land shall be found to contain any Minerals, the Governor for the time being of Our said State may thereupon cancel, wholly or in part, the grant of the said land upon the terms and in the manner provided in any Acts in force for the time being for the regulation of mining in Our said State: And, upon notification of such cancellation, the said land, or so much as may be included in the said notification, shall thereupon revert to Us, Our Heirs and Successors, and this Our Grant shall, to the extent aforesaid, cease to operate or to have effect: **Provided** Also, AND WE DO HEREBY FURTHER EXCEPT AND RESERVE unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, all such parts, and so much of the said land as may hereafter be required for a Public Way, or Public Ways, Viaducts, Canals, Dams, Sewers, or Drains, in, over, and through the same, to be set out by Our Governor for the time being of Our said State, or some person by him authorized in that respect: AND ALSO all Sand, Clay, Stone, Gravel, and Indigenous Timber, and all other Materials, the natural produce of the said land, which may be required at any time or times hereafter by the Government of Our said State, for the construction and repair of any Public Ways, Bridges, or Canals, or for Naval purposes, or Railways and Tramways, or any Fences, Embankments, Viaducts, Dams, Sewers, or Drains necessary for the same, together with the right of taking and removing all such Materials by such person or persons as may be authorized in that behalf by the Governor for the time being of Our said State: **Provided** Further, AND WE DO HEREBY ALSO RESERVE unto Us, Our Heirs and Successors, and to the Governor for the time being of Our said State, by such person or persons as shall be by Them or Him authorized in that behalf, full power to make and conduct through, in, under, upon, or over the said land, or any portion thereof, all Common or Public Drains and Sewers which may be deemed expedient: AND the right of full and free ingress, egress, and regress, into, out of, and upon the said land, for the several purposes aforesaid, or any of them: **In Testimony Whereof**, We have caused this Our Grant to be Sealed with the Seal of Our said State.

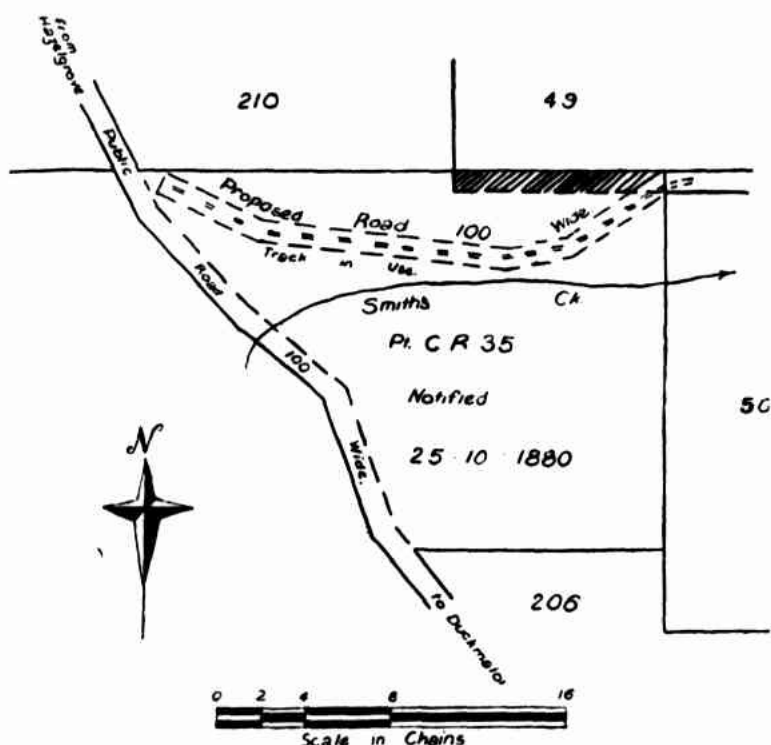

Good talking to you today, it has been a while.

As discussed, I am assisting in progressing matters concerning the proposed Avonlie solar farm.

A Submission for the proposal was received from the Department of Industry – Water Division on 6 September 2018. It states:

“The EIS contains no record of Narrandera Shire Council’s consent for the proponent to access and take water from the council-owned standpipe during construction and operation of the proposed development. It is recommended that the proponent should apply for consent from Narrandera Shire Council to take and use water from the council standpipe”.

To meet the criteria of the Submission, NGH Environmental request approval in principle on behalf of the proponent, RES Australia, prior to formal application from M Hannan Water and Truck Hire for use of water from a council standpipe for the construction and operational stages of the proposed Avonlie Solar Farm.

As per the EIS, the following water quantities are required:

Construction

Water use during construction will be minimal and largely used for dust suppression on unsealed roads and for the construction of new roads. The water requirement will vary, dependent on weather conditions, and is estimated to be up to 11.2ML in total over the 18 month construction period.

Approximately, 0.34ML of potable water would also be required for the amenity of employees and contractors.

Operation

Requirements would be minor in comparison to the construction phase.

It is envisaged that water usage would only occur should the solar plant require cleaning, which is not always the case.

Should water be required, it would be sourced primarily from existing dams on the development site, and secondly trucked in from the Narrandera Shire Depot standpipe.

I think I can give you some concrete advice now.

You can assume presence for the purposes of writing the BDAR and using the calculator for these threatened species, for which **area** is the unit of measure, and this would be sufficient if the species weren't classed under the SAI category.

However, you do need to address all the requirements in section 10.2.3 *Additional impact assessment provisions for threatened species and populations* of the BAM to provide the information for us to make the decision about SAI. This means justifying statements and conclusions for each subsection of s.10.2.3. You can use published information, grey reports, information from reference sites if available and other legitimate data sources for instance.

This is where an expert report may come in. If you feel that you can't provide this information through your own company expertise you will need an expert report. Before you get someone to do the work you need to contact us to get that person approved for the job.

I believe you have spoken to our Saving our Species program already and they may be able to advise you about an appropriate person for the task, if you don't know people through your own networks.

I hope this is specific enough for you to move forward with the assessment. If not please get back to me at your convenience.

SAI

NGH propose to survey for the two identified Orchids that form the SAI in September and November. Details of the survey would be provided as part of the Response to Submissions in the Submissions Report (SR) and an addendum BDAR provided.

The new proposed transmission line will also be surveyed, and results provided in the SR and addendum BDAR. As discussed, we will complete a floristic plot in this area. Please see attached plan and spatial data for the location of the transmission line.

Please confirm the following:

- Is the survey effort sufficient given the poor climatic conditions?
- If presence is not detected at either survey, will a specialist report be required despite the survey effort?
- If presence is either detected or assumed (either through NGH survey or specialist report), what is the course of action?

On speaking to our Senior Archaeologist, they have suggested that we re-invite the RAPS to survey the proposed transmission line route, and provide the detail in an addendum ACHAR. Re-advertisement for RAPS and survey methodology would not be required (as they would not change from the previous survey), but RAPS would be given the opportunity to attend the site visit and comment on the addendum report. The Senior Archaeologist believes this is important given the level and number of artefacts found on-site. Please confirm if the proposed is sufficient.

It is important to note that the new proposed transmission line is in land owned by the existing involved landowner, is through exotic pasture along a fence line to reduce any agricultural impacts (allowing for an easement), is above ground with very little overall disturbance (minor excavation for poles only), and a maintenance/access track is not required in the transmission easement.
