Also am concerned about heritage
item at Blues Point.

Having viewed the EIS, I find it
unfortunate that all of the old shops
located within the proposed Metro
railway station areas are to be
demolished. I am also concerned about
the works at Blues Point, and whether
the former carferry docks at the
entrance on the (waters edge) will be
be kept.

I understand that a heritage study
was conducted in all these areas.

However I believe the following should
be retained

① Proposed Crows Nest Station.

Shop fronts (facades) 501 (Proud
Furniture) 465 (02 Design) 465 A
459 - 467 - 469 A - 471 - 473 - 475.

Having viewed the buildings in the
area I believe the shop fronts are
worth retaining.

② Proposed Victoria Cross Station,

I would argue for the retention of the heritage listed shop front at 187 Miller Street

I believe the front of this building should be preserved,

As well I believe the sculpture that presently sits outside 189 Miller Street should be placed back there in situ once the station development is completed.

③ Blues Point Worksite

I am most concerned that during construction works that the former heritage car ferry dock entrance, may be damaged or removed

However it appears on the EIS that the works should not affect them as they are close to the waters edge.

I would strongly ask you to consider the above proposals and whether part or whole of them could be implemented.
