Reference is made to your recent request in regards to the above mentioned proposed development.

Roads and Maritime Services advise that the proposal, has been assessed as having minimal impact on navigation, provided the following conditions are met:

- The proponent is to supply & install appropriate shoreline signage ie; "Warning Submerged Pipeline" (Re: Roads and Maritime for guidelines)
- The proponent is to supply & install five yellow SLB600 Aquabuoys, signwritten "Warning Submerged Pipeline" (Re: Roads and Maritime for guidelines)
- The Aquabuoys must be attached to the pipelines at their junction point 200m from the shore and then midway along each pipeline and at the end of each pipeline
- The two Aquabuoys marking the end of each pipeline must be lit with a yellow flashing SL60 light
- The Aquabuoys and lights are to be serviced annually and properly maintained

Should the proposal change after receiving comment from Roads and Maritime, it will be necessary to resubmit the amended plans for assessment along with an inspection fee.
