The Human Health Risk Assessment completed for the site is supported as it appears to have considered the various stages of construction, deconstruction, demolition and remediation of the site.

It is also noted that other concerns raised at a previous site visit by SafeWork NSW representatives have been addressed in the following attachments:

- The complexities potentially encountered when demolishing the 3 towers amongst other structures. EIS -Demolition and remediation – 8.7.1 – refers to a tender process that is currently underway inviting reputable, experienced and qualified demolition contractors to provide Hydro with a scope and fee for undertaking demolition.
- Concerns regarding worker safety during the relocation of the contaminated material from the existing stockpile to the containment cell referred to in appendix 6, 7 & 8.
