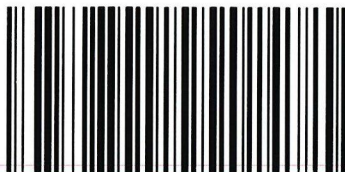

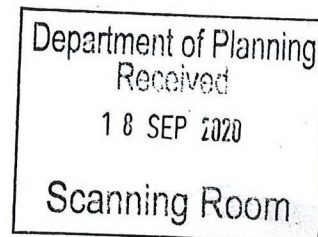
Dear sir
