To the Department of Planning - Major Projects,

I would like to show my support for the proposed development of the Kariong Sand and Soil Supplies Facility.

- Creating local jobs
- A boost to local economy
- A sustainable vision for the Central Coast
- Diverting waste from landfill.
- A need to recycle building materials on the Central Coast is most definitely the major reason I would like to see this facility go ahead. I have a contracting business where we supply & install plasterboard linings to approximately 12 builders in the Central Coast and Hunter regions. We are being asked more and more regarding recycling of plasterboard waste, as most of the off cuts of plasterboard end up in landfill. There is a recycling facility in Mayfield (Newcastle) but it is uneconomical for me to send our Central Coast recycling to Newcastle, so it ends up in landfill. This can be anywhere up to 500-600sqm (3-4 tonnes) of plasterboard off cuts per week.

If a recycling facility were available in Somersby we would ensure all of our plasterboard off cuts from the Hunter and Central Coast regions would be taken there.
