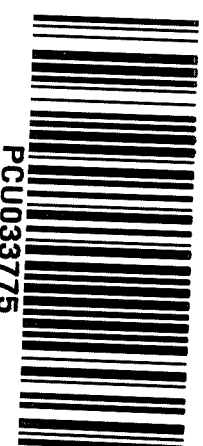

I am a resident at 6 Oliver Way Cherrybrook and act on behalf of myself and my husband John Drussel, the owners of the above mentioned property.

I am writing to object to the development of the NWRL Site for Cherrybrook Station located next to our home at Oliver Way. My objections are as follows:  
Lack of Information:

IN ORDER TO MAKE A CLEAR ASSESSMENT OF HOW THIS CONSTRUCTION WILL AFFECT MY PROPERTY, I WOULD NEED TO HAVE A BETTER INDICATION OF WHERE FACILITIES ARE TO BE PLACED.

ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS:

THE LOCATION OF OUR HOME IS UNDER THREAT WITH THE PROPOSAL TO CONSTRUCT RIGHT NEXT TO OLIVER WAY. WE PURCHASED HERE TO BE IN A QUIET PEACEFUL ROAD.

AIR POLLUTION CONTROL - HEALTH ISSUES

I OBJECT TO THE AIR POLLUTION WHICH WILL BE CAUSED AS I SUFFER A CHRONIC LUNG CONDITION (BRONCHIECTASIS) AND HAVE CONSEQUENTLY HAD MY A PORTION OF MY LEFT LUNG REMOVED AND MY ADDITIONAL DUST IN THE ATMOSPHERE WOULD GREATLY IMPACT ON MY ABILITY TO BREATHE. (I AM ABLE TO OBTAIN DOCUMENTATION FROM MY RESPIRATORY PHYSICIAN TO VERIFY THIS.) I ALREADY NEED TO USE A NEBULISER MACHINE 3 TIMES DAILY TO AID MY BREATHING.

## NOISE AND VIBRATION:

I OBJECT TO THE NOISE AND VIBRATION AS MY HUSBAND AND I ARE RETIRED AND MOSTLY CONFINED TO HOME AT OLIVER MAY. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT THE SIX METER SOUND BARRIER IS ERECTED, ALTHOUGH SUCH A WALL WOULD TOWER OVER OUR HOME AND OUR PROPERTY WOULD HAVE TO FACE IT.

## TRAFFIC CONGESTION:

OLIVER MAY is a narrow road that relies on Robert Road to gain entry & exit our homes. Robert Road is already dangerous and any extra traffic would make it unbearable.

The volume of trucks daily using the construction site is also of great concern.

It is felt that this NWRL Cherry brook construction site will have both a disturbing mental and physical impact on our lives -
