5. What are the consequences for the roads leading to this development both for pedestrians + for cars in both Caroline St, Eveleigh St, Hugo St, Lawson St?

These roads are currently completely congested with parked cars, busy moving traffic + thousands of student pedestrians both morning + night.

6. As a resident who is a carer of a permanently disabled man, I struggle daily to find a parking space close to our home. This makes getting my disabled brother into + out of the car even more difficult as he can only walk a few slow steps.

If parking becomes worse then this problem will be exacerbated.

We say a big NO to this development. Anything more than 6 storeys is too much for this area.

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
