I object to the construction of the proposed solar farm in the location as proposed, as the proposed location is on the floodplain of the Murrumbidgee River.

Letter to the Carroll to Boggabri flood study and compilation of data, prepared by Shawe Mountain Engineering Corporation in 2003, for the Department of Land and Water Conservation.

A floodplain management plan for the floodplain of the Murrumbidgee River and Mooki River, between Carroll and Boggabri, prepared by Webb, McKeon and Associates Pty Ltd for the Department of Infrastructure, Planning and Natural Resources, later the Department of Natural Resources, was finalised in September 2006.

Aerial photographs, reference N.SW 3363 [W1573] taken for the C.M.A. were taken of the flood plain in the Murrumbidgee and Mooki rivers on the 31st January 1984. The water level in the rivers

at the river gauge, Chen's Bridge, Gunnedah, was listed 8.84m. The aerial photograph, Run #1025, in the series of photographs, shows the extent of the inundation over portion of the construction site.

The construction of the solar farm, in the location as proposed on the floodplain is not environmentally friendly or unreasonably sound.
