

Amazing finally a project that is a good news story, for a community that was almost destroyed by a mining company. This could be a new future for Wollar. This project will help power the national electricity grid, producing 290 mega watts of green power with battery storage. This power will allow up to 104,926 average homes in NSW to turn on their lights etc. Displacing approximately 515,564 metric tonnes of CO₂ which will support Australian climate change commitments.

- (1) there is no land conflict from this project in the area.
