Station type	Single-span (cut-and-cover) cavern with island platform
Transport interchange	Walking, cycling, bus, taxi and kiss-and-ride
Station entry / exit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>On the corner of Hume and Clarke Streets</li> <li>On the corner of Pacific Highway and Oxley Street</li> </ul>
Customers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Existing residents within walking and cycling distance</li> <li>Visitors and patrons accessing the leisure and retail strip along Willoughby Road</li> <li>Existing employment area along Willoughby Road, Christie Street and the Pacific Highway</li> </ul>
