## Mount Owen Continued Operations Project (SSD 5850 MOD 2) Response to Submissions

I refer to your email of 7 January 2019 to the Department of Industry (DoI) in respect to the above matter. Comment has been sought from relevant branches of Lands & Water and Department of Primary Industries. Any further referrals to Department of Industry can be sent by email to landuse.enquiries@dpi.nsw.gov.au.

The department provides the following comments and recommendations for consideration in assessment of the proposal.

## **Dol - Water and Natural Resources Access Regulator**

- The following conditions of consent are recommended:
  - A Water Management Plan should be prepared in consultation with Dol Water/NRAR, including a monitoring plan and Trigger Action Response Plan to identify, monitor and manage impacts to the alluvial groundwater resource of Main Creek.
  - Licensed entitlement must be obtained to account for all take of water (unless subject to exemption) prior to take of water occurring.
- Guidelines/policies that should be addressed.
  - NSW Aguifer Interference Policy 2012

## **Dol - Crown Lands**

- All Crown Land and Crown Roads within a Mining Lease must be subject to a Compensation Agreement issued under Section 265 of the *Mining Act 1992*, to be agreed and executed prior to any mining activity taking place and within 12 months of Project/Modification approval. The Compensation Agreement may include conditions requiring the Mining Lease Holder to purchase Crown Land impacted on by mining activity.
- All Crown Land and Crown Roads located within an Exploration Licence, where subject to
  exploration activity, must be subject to an Access Arrangement issued under Section 141 of
  the Mining Act 1992, to be agreed and executed prior to any exploration activity taking place
