"The new down relief rail line would be approximately 11 metres closer to Yarrara Road than the existing rail alignments – the new station building would be approximately 8 metres closer to the Road than the existing station. This would reduce over time with the establishment of new vegetation"

## Questions -

What does 'down' mean?
Where exactly would the 11 metres place the new rail line?
Is in the middle of Yarrara Road a reasonable estimate?
Where exactly would the 8 metres place the new station buildings?
Is beyond the pavement right at the Yarrara Road / Ramsay Road intersection a reason estimate?
Will the placements of the rail line and the new station building move 'over time' through the pressure of new vegetation?
