I support the Project because Rail is needed to relieve increasing freight transport by road & the congestion it causes. Rail moves much greater amounts of freight separated from cars & people.

But

The proposal does not list any improvement to passenger access to Beccroft Station - currently only a long steep flight of stairs possibly part of the original construction of the Station. Beccroft is a commercial centre and is a Bus terminus serving passengers to and from the station. A petition for a LIFT to aid access for young people with prams & young children & for people with disabilities was presented some time ago (? years) & that this is not being implemented as part of such a major Rail project, I hope is an oversight & not a deliberate omission. Please include this in your plans - It is truly needed.
