I Donald Clarke have lived and owned the premises of 789 Tarean Rd Kareelah since 1988.

I have observed the wild life and plants before the quarries were operating and right up until this point of time and watched them destroy a large percentage of fruiting fig trees, wild grapevines that the animals depend on for survival, such as scrub-larks, rare eastern quails, fig-tree sugar gliders, possums and black yellow tailed cockatoos which live and nest in the old growth seed trees in Michael Kileys Quarry area as well as Mr Greigons Quarry sites where he destroyed a large section of significant and rare rain forest from this area and changed the rule from local council to state significant development to bring on the rules set down for the Quarry operation dust control and enclosures, also noise control. The concern is if this is not addressed the increase of dust particles in the air will be life threatening. I am writing in sincere hope and concern that Michael Kileys operation will abide by the rules and operation to save human and animal life.
