RE: Objection to Karuah South Quarry – SSD 17-8795

I am writing to lodge my objection to the above 'proposed gravel mine', because:-

the proposed Quarry will be allowed to discharge their dirty run off water into Yalimbah Creek, which directly flows into the Karuah River, then into Port Stephens.. This Creek is an important breeding ground for prawns, fish and marine life. The proposed area is also a known area for Koala, Quolls, and Phascogales, whose habitat will be cleared.

If this mine is approved it should be a controlled action with conditions of consent.
