I am writing to lodge my objection to the above 'proposed gravel mine', because:-

There is too many quarries in this area of natural bushland and the death of wildlife impacts is shameful and catastrophic if this Karuah South Quarry is approved. Why do you Government Departments allow wildlife annihilation when you should be protecting wildlife of threatened, vulnerable, Endangered Government listing including our plant species. (No discharge approvals either)
