Agency Comment – Modification of Development Consent: Glen Innes Wind Farm MP07_0036 MOD 4

I refer to your letter dated 3 July 2014 seeking comments from the NSW Rural Fire Service regarding the above mentioned development.

The NSW Rural Fire Service (RFS) understands the modification proposal consists of the following amendment:

- Glen Innes Wind Farm proposes to use turbines with longer blades and correspondingly taller towers;
- Electricity generation will increase to 90 MW;
- Turbines are proposed to be located in slightly different locations to avoid boundary interference and to maximise wind flows;
- Minor changes to ancillary infrastructure are also proposed.

The RFS has no objection to the modification proposal proceeding, providing the bush fire conditions, numbered 2.35, 2.36, and 2.37, contained in the Project Approval Notice of Development Consent, Consolidated Conditions of Approval dated January 2016, remain unchanged.
