My Brother and I agist our horses at Minumurra Stud in the Matheson Valley. We were out at the Stud the other day to see them . While we were there the noise coming from the White Rock Wind farm on the western side of the Valley was in our opinion "ridiculously Loud!"

We are told that if the Mod 4 goes through with the Glen Innes Wind Farm turbines proposed for the eastern side of the Valley, that they will be even bigger and we assume even noisier.
