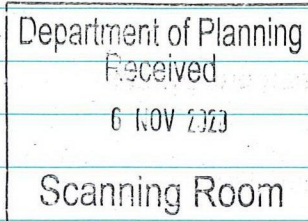

(Flood Plain) on a slightly higher part of it.

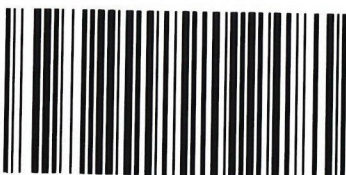
This is Prime Agriculture Land (1st class Land)
