- 2. Replace all references to "Director-General" with "Planning Secretary"; "Department of Planning" with "Department"; "Principal Certifying Authority (PCA)" with "PCA"; "RTA" with "RMS"; "shall" with "must", "waste water" with "wastewater" and "DA-05\_0080" with "05\_0080", wherever occurring.
- 3. Delete Condition 1.1, accompanying table and subheading "Scope of Development" and replace with new subheadings and new Conditions 1.1 to 1.1C:

#### **Obligation to Minimise Harm to the Environment**

1.1 In addition to meeting the specific performance measures and criteria in this consent, all reasonable and feasible measures must be implemented to prevent, and if prevention is not reasonable and feasible, minimise, any material harm to the environment that may result from the construction and operation of the development, and any rehabilitation required under this consent.

#### **Terms of Consent**

- 1.1A The development may only be carried out:
  - (a) in compliance with the conditions of this consent;
  - (b) in accordance with all written directions of the Planning Secretary;
  - (c) in accordance with the EA documents outlined in Appendix A;
  - (d) in accordance with the Development Layout in Appendix B;
  - (e) in accordance with MOD 1; and
  - (f) in accordance with MOD 2.
- 1.1B. Consistent with the requirements in this consent, the Planning Secretary may make written directions to the Applicant in relation to:
  - (a) the content of any strategy, study, system, plan, program, review, audit, notification, report or correspondence submitted under or otherwise made in relation to this consent, including those that are required to be, and have been, approved by the Planning Secretary; and
  - (b) the implementation of any actions or measures contained in any such document referred to in condition 1.1B(a).
- 1.1C. The conditions of this consent and directions of the Planning Secretary prevail to the extent of any inconsistency, ambiguity or conflict between them and a document listed in condition 1.1A(c), (e) or (f). In the event of an inconsistency, ambiguity or conflict between any of the documents listed in conditions 1.1A(c), (e) or (f), the most recent document prevails to the extent of the inconsistency, ambiguity or conflict.
- 4. Delete Condition 1.8 and subheading "Inconsistencies".
- 5. Insert new subheading and Condition 1.23, as follows

#### Structural Adequacy of Early Works

- 1.23 Within six months of the date of the approval of MOD 2, the Applicant must:
  - (a) obtain and provide copies to the Planning Secretary all necessary building information certificate(s) from Council for any structures proposed as part of MOD 2 that have been constructed or partially constructed prior to the approval of MOD 2; and
  - (b) ensure that all new structures, and any alterations or additions to existing structures, are constructed in accordance with the relevant requirements of the Building Code of Australia.
- 6. In subheading titled "Wastewater Utilisation Areas" after the heading Waste Management Impacts Processing Water, insert the words "and Rotation Plan" after the words "Areas".

- 7. Delete Condition 3.21 and insert the new Condition 3.21:
- 3.21 Wastewater must only be applied to the areas listed in the following table:

- 8. Delete Condition 4.5
- 9. Insert new Condition 6.5(a)(1), after Condition 6.5(a) as follows:
  - (a)(1). The Applicant must update and implement the Groundwater Management Plan to incorporate details of the rotation plan and additional WWUA lots approved under MOD 2. This plan is to update the plan approved under Condition 6.5(a) and must also:
    - (a) be submitted to the Planning Secretary for approval at least two months prior to the use of any land parcels other than those described in Rotation A in Condition 3.21; and
    - (b) contain details of the revised groundwater monitoring regime for the additional WWUA lots
- 10. Insert new Condition 6.5(b)(1), after Condition 6.5(b) as follows:
  - (b)(1). The Applicant must update and implement the Irrigation and Wastewater Management Plan to incorporate details of the rotation plan and additional WWUA lots approved under MOD 2. This plan is to update the plan approved under Condition 6.5(b) and must also:
    - (a) be submitted to the Planning Secretary for approval at least two months prior to the use of any land parcels other than those described in Rotation A in Condition 3.21; and
    - (b) contains details of the:
      - i. rotation plan;
      - revised monitoring program for soil quality, nutrient and salt levels for the additional WWUA lots; and
      - iii. additional management and mitigation measures to manage irrigation application for the additional WWUA lots.
- 11. Insert new Appendix A after Condition 7.4 and a new table titled "Environmental Assessment and Response to Submissions Documentation" as shown in Attachment A of this modifying instrument




Figure 2: Wastewater Utilisation Area Rotation Plan

- 12. Insert new Appendix B after Appendix A titled "Development Site Layout Plans" and new figures 1 and 2 as shown in Attachment B of this modifying instrument.
