Dear David,

I refer to your email regarding the additional traffic information for the Moorebank Recycling Facility.

Roads and Maritime has reviewed the additional information and notes that, in accordance with the information submitted by McLaren Traffic Engineering, traffic control signals are not required to service the combined development of Marina and Recycling Facility in terms of traffic volume.

However, the traffic consultant was trying to argue for a special case to provide traffic control signals without providing any actual details of crash history, actual sight distance issues etc at this location.

In other words, the proposed intersection would operate efficiently under priority control and there are no known safety issues at this location.

Therefore, based on the information provided, Roads and Maritime does not support the provision of traffic control signals to service the combined developments.
