Orora (formerly AMCOR) New Paper Mill Project, Matraville in the Randwick LGA, Proposed Modification – additional demolition works MP 05_0120)

I refer to your email dated 24 February 2015 to the Department of Primary Industries in respect of the above matter.

Comment by NSW Office of Water

The NSW Office of Water (NOW) has reviewed the Modification Report. The NSW Office of Water notes the following:

- That there will be no impact to groundwater sources as the building slabs will remain in place and all exposed areas will be sealed immediately.
- That a Surface Water Management Plan will be developed to minimise the risks of possibly polluted surface water reaching Botany Bay.

It is noted that Orora has water access licences and approvals for extraction of groundwater to feed Mill 9.

There are no further issues with the modification as presented.
